CONTEXT

The pace at which bio-economy is happening is not balanced in Europe, with 'moderate/modest innovator' countries lagging behind. This may be the result of insufficient knowledge of the potential for the bio-based industry **in** these countries, including supportive mechanisms. But it also has to do with insufficient knowledge **about** these countries in the EU, as well as of policies that do not account for their specificity.
