CENTRAL-EUROPEAN ALTERNATIVE ENERGY SUMMIT IN BUDAPEST:

Sustainable energy systems for CEE countries workshop

Energiaklub Climate Policy Institute and Applied Communications, and the Green Workshop Foundation organise a workshop for alternative energy planners and modelling experts in K11 (Király u. 11.) Budapest, 3rd of November 2016, 9:00-15:30.

The aim of our event is to present the experiences with energy modelling from various EU countries (e.g. Hungary, Denmark, Germany, the Balkans), thus allowing Central- and East-European (CEE) countries to build upon these in their own energy models. The event and the exchange of experiences is also meant to support regional cooperation by initiating the use of innovative planning tools and regional solutions as a response to energy-related challenges.

Lead energy specialists, professors and researchers as well as international bodies will represent their views and experiences regarding past and possible future alternative energy visions and roadmaps.

***Content:** In the first section of the conference we provide European examples to learn from. At first, Danish methodology of energy modelling and the main results of the German Energiewende will be presented. Afterwards, the Hungarian This way ahead! research group and the authors of the Alternative and Sustainable Energy Scenarios for Hungary will present their alternative energy models.*

In the afternoon programme, experts from the Czech Republic, Poland, Croatia and Bulgaria (countries to be fixed) will present their alternative energy models and their experiences with the uptake of their findings in national strategies and policies.

Finally, a panel session will provide room for reflections, especially regarding the opportunities for cooperation in energy modelling and strategy planning with a focus on the CEE region.

The working language of the workshop will be English, we do not provide interpreters.
